- Since you will be sedated for this exam, **you CANNOT drive** or operate machinery for 12-24 hours following the test. **You must be accompanied by a companion and make arrangements for transportation** or you will not be given the sedation.
- It is very important that you strictly follow the instruction:

• As Soon As You Get This Instruction:

- o <u>Check your medication</u> and make necessary adjustments if you take blood thinners or diabetic drugs (see below).
- o <u>Make arrangements for transportation</u> since you are not allowed to drive due to sedation.
- o Go to pharmacy and buy the following medications (these are over-the-counter medications and you do not need a prescription):
 - One 32 oz Gatorade bottle (not red or purple) and 119 gm (or 1 bottle of 238 gm) of Miralax.
 - Two Fleet Enemas.

• In the Evening Before the Procedure:

- o At 5:00 PM, mix and drink 119 gm (or half of 238 gm) of the Miralax in the 32 oz of Gatorade.
- o At 7:00 PM, use one Fleet Enema.
- o Do not have anything to eat after midnight.

• On the Day Of the Procedure:

- o <u>Use the other Fleet Enema two hours before the procedure.</u>
- o Nothing to eat or drink before procedure (no candy, cough drops, gum, chewing tobacco or snuff). The exception is your necessary medications (heart, blood pressure, seizure, anxiety, etc) with a small sip of water.

• Medication Concerns:

- o If you take <u>BLOOD THINNERS</u> like <u>warfarin (Coumadin</u>), apixaban (<u>Eliquis</u>), rivaroxaban (<u>Xarelto</u>), or others, you will need to contact your prescribing doctor to ask if you can hold this medication prior to your procedure. In general, Coumadin needs to be held for 5 days (need to make arrangements to have clotting tests (PT/INR) done prior to your procedure. This can be done the day before your test), Eliquis 2 days, and Xarelto 2 days. Baby aspirin does not need to be held.
- o If you are diabetic and require <u>insulin</u> or <u>diabetic medicine</u>, your dose may need to be adjusted because of the dietary changes associated with this test. You will need to contact your doctor that orders your medications for directions.
- o If you take certain injections for diabetes or weight loss such as semaglutide (**Ozempic**, **Wegovy**), tirzepatide (**Mounjaro**, **Zepbound**), or dulaglutide (**Trulicity**), you will need to hold dose 7 days prior to your exam (you will need to contact your prescribing doctor if you can hold it).
